Default Airspace

The purpose of this brief is to understand the default airspace boundaries.

- It comprises a classroom brief with a cadet instructor (or a delegated instructor).
- A downloadable* default airspace map, which should be printed out and carried with your logbook.
- As well as understanding the default line, you should learn the features that separate the 3000' agl area and the 4000' agl area to the North of the club.
- When the opportunity arises you should attend a full airspace presentation.
